Qualifications

- Doctoral degree in Nursing or related field, with at least one graduate degree in nursing consistent with the department specialty foci
- Qualifications and experience to meet criteria for appointment at Associate or Full Professor rank
- Sustained history of externally funded research including, but not limited to, NIH funding
- A record of publication in top tiered journals in nursing and related disciplines
- Teaching and administrative experience in baccalaureate, master's and doctoral programs
- Demonstrated leadership abilities including skill in collaboration with a community of scholars
- Commitment to diversity and a multicultural environment
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Currently licensed or eligible for licensure to practice nursing in Virginia

Desired Qualifications

- Nurse practitioner licensure preferred

Responsibilities

In addition to responsibilities of a tenured faculty member, the department chair:

- Provides leadership in faculty recruitment; development across teaching, research and service, and evaluation.
- Leads department in the full range of curriculum activities including planning, implementation, instruction and evaluation of department based specialty tracks and courses.
- Manages overall functioning of the department, including administration of department fiscal affairs in accordance with University policies.
- Facilitates development of department and school climate that promotes an integrated academic life for individual faculty and community of scholars for the School
